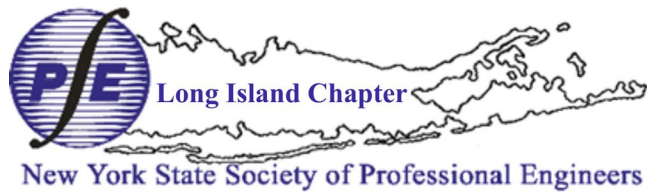
### **C3 of Electric Power via CoGeneration**

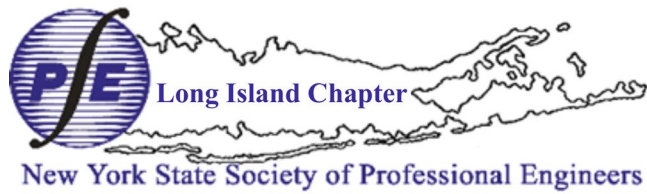

**located on the east side (Route 454) - before crossing (Route 347)  
Just 2 buildings away from (Route 111 crossing Route 454) - on the east side (Route 454)**

**EAST**

**(East On Route 347)**

**East bound** on (Route 347) merge right onto (Route 454)  
first light (Route 111) make left uturn. We are on the right.

**(East On LIE)**

**Exit 57** - 2nd light make left onto Route 454 / Veterans Hwy.  
We are the 2nd building on right crossing over Route 111.

**WEST**

**(West On Route 347)**

**West bound** on (Route 347) pass over (Route 454) make left uturn at that first light after,  
merge right onto (Route 454) first light (Route 111) make left uturn. We are on the right.

**(West On LIE)**

**Exit 57** - make right at the first light onto Route 454 / Veterans Hwy.  
We are the 2nd building on right crossing over Route 111.

(Route 454 is Veterans Hwy.)  
(Route 347 is Smithtown Bypass)  
(Route 111 is Wheeler Road)
