
Session 1: "Engineers' Ethics: Engineering ethics is a crucial aspect of professional practice that involves the moral principles and standards that guide engineers in their work. Engineers are expected to adhere to a code of ethics that promotes integrity, accountability, and public welfare. The NYSED enforces a code of ethics for Professional Engineers that includes provisions for professional conduct, competence, and responsibility to the public. Topics in to be discussed are: Public Safety and Welfare, Honesty and Integrity, Competence and Professional Development, Confidentiality, Sustainability and Environmental Responsibility, Fairness and Equity, and Conflict of Interests

Session 2: "Limiting Potential Engineers' Liability": Engineers can be held liable for errors, omissions, or negligence in their professional activities. Understanding these liabilities is crucial for engineers to mitigate risks and ensure compliance with legal and professional standards. Topic areas of Engineering Liability include Professional Negligence, Breach of Contract, Product Liability, Strict Liability, Environmental Liability, and Third-Party Liability. Also to be discussed are Standard of Care, Insurance, Statutes of Limitation, and How to avoid potential liability
